TIPS FOR ALL MEMBERS

SCHEDULES: Rides scheduled every Wed & Sun, year round, weather pending. In case of bad weather we may change plans and do 'pop-up' rides on alternative days. Monitor social media.

KICK STANDS UP (KSU): KSU=Departure Time, which is <u>strictly</u> adhered to because of planned routes and stops.. Gear up, gas up, dress up, and get your engine fired up at the designated departure time. Be advised we do not waver from KSU time: we do not wait.

BREAKFASTS: Enjoy a pre-ride breakfast and lively conversation at the designated location. Allow an hour extra prior to KSU time. If skipping breakfast, arrive 15 minutes prior to KSU time.

RIDE LEADERS: On any day, 1-3 routes are available from which to choose. Routes are announced following breakfast. If you don't like the route, it's all about freedom. You can make your own route by leading a ride. It's just choosing a place you like to go and taking us there. We encourage more ride leaders: you can be one and show us your style. Talk to an officer or a ride leader to learn more.

COMMON RIDE PROTOCOLS: Motorcycling has risks. We respect the general safety protocols of the NJ State Police MotorCops. That is *staggered formation* and the *two-second rule*. No side-by -side riding. No passing while in motion. Allow a two second time-gap between you and the bike directly in front. If you do not understand these, we are willing to give our best interpretation.

RIDING WITH YOUR RIDE LEADER: Each ride leader has a style, their focus could be: scenic, relaxed, food mission, landmark, twisty, spirited, or other. Know that ride leaders have planned goals to get through the day and return home by a reasonable time. Leaders need all to move as a unit, and keep up. If you cannot keep up, leave the ride: never ride under pressure, because that is your sign to find a ride leader whose style suits you.

FREEDOM TO MAKE EVERY RIDE YOUR RIDE: At *any time* for *any reason* you may bow out of a ride. Take full responsibility for *your* ride, *your* abilities, *your* protective wear, *your* comfort level and the condition of *your* gear and *your* bike. And if you're only available a portion of the day, come ride and peel off when needed.

TYPICAL DAY RIDES: Day rides are within region (NJ,DE,PA,MD), generally within a 75 mile radius of departure point. The intent is a ride plus comfort stops and lunch stops, then head homeward. Typically, about 150 miles round trip, and riders make it home before supper time.

RALLIES and EXCURSIONS: We sometimes participate in rallies for our organization and others.

COMMUNICATION & CB ETIQUETTE: We use CB radio. It's not required but having one is a plus. Use channel 32 for essential ride info: please switch over to channel 30 for social conversation.

MEMBERSHIPS: Run Jan 1st to Dec 31st. Only those maintaining up-to-date membership may participate in rides & events. New members joining Oct/Nov/Dec grandfathered in for next year.
